Following the flu vaccination, most people do not have any problems. However, it is possible to develop redness/swelling at your injection site, headache and temperature for a few days afterwards.

Flu vaccination becomes effective within 1-3 weeks of being given. Protection lasts for approximately 9 months. Although you have been vaccinated against flu, this does not mean you are immune to colds and coughs or even all types of influenza this winter. The priority is to protect people against the common and serious forms of influenza.
